Then we will answer questions, lay out your activities menu and discuss various options to help you get ready for your exclusive adventure on the Sea of Cortez; how this day plays out will be determined by your capacity to enjoy yourselves - nothing is set in stone. This experience is all about you.





Baja Sur Adventure

Days 3 to Day 8: After some basic packing, paddling and safety instruction, we will glide off to a great adventure in the Sea of Cortez. If winds are high, no worries... we'll spend time helping you explore the desert flora and mysteries of the tide pools or we can enjoy as many aspects of Baja exploration and Mexican culture as you wish. Daily paddling schedules often involve early morning departures to avoid traveling in possible choppy conditions later in the day – beautiful thing about the yacht is that we can always find “flat water”. Travel times between play sites is up to you. We will plan our routes to avoid backtracking along the best of the inaccessible and island coastlines.

On the last day of the tour we arrive back in Loreto as you wish, giving you time for an afternoon of small town life and shopping. In the evening we can be off to a local restaurant for a farewell dinner. Other options include: mountain biking, golf, or hiking allowing a different perspective of the Sea of Cortez and the Sierra de la Giganta range.

Day 9: Morning free to shop and relax, before your afternoon departure to the airport, we'll have your new friends bid you adios and send you back to your home.
